

Devil O' The Highlands 43 Mile Footrace



Tyndrum – Fort William Saturday 7th August 2010

The "Devil O' the Highlands " is a 43 mile (69.2 km) race starting from Tyndrum and finishing in Fort William following the West Highland Way trail. You have 12 hours to finish the race and there are manned checkpoints throughout that you must reach.

This race is ideal for anyone who wishes to experience real Ultra-distance running in the excellent company of fellow runners and the views of some of Scotlands most beautiful scenery. (unless of course the mist comes down)

You must have motorised backup (car, van,etc.) and a backup crew (one of which must be a runner themselves) to meet you at the checkpoints along the route. It is their responsibility to supply you with food, drink and clothing during the race. It is also their responsibility to go and find you should you not make a checkpoint.

As it is a mountain event the minimum survival equipment must be carried at all times.

The 'Devil O' The Highlands' starts at 6am on the morning of Saturday 7th August 2010 from the "Green Welly Stop" car park in the High Street, Tyndrum. The owners of the complex have once again graciously offered to open the shop to allow us the use of their facilities. Tea, Coffee and last minute food supplies can also be purchased.

This is a pre-entry event only. Entries will close when we reach our maximum. Forms must be received by 1st June 2010 at the latest. Under no circumstances will entries be accepted on the day of the race. (Maximum number of competitors 120)
